Policy Statement:

The Town of Cardston is committed to the wise management of the community's water quantity and quality for the benefit of residents now and in the future. Water is not only a resource, it is a life source. We all share the responsibility to ensure a healthy, secure and sustainable water supply for our community, environment and economy – our quality of life depends on it.

Therefore, the Town of Cardston will make available reliable information and technical assistance to the public for use in developing effective and efficient water conservation programs. Also, the Town will from time to time, when budgetary considerations deem it appropriate, provide incentive programs to encourage residents to reduce water consumption and encourage conservation.

Guidelines

- 1) All incentive programs must be approved by Council prior to implementation.
- 2) Incentive Programs will be reviewed for effectiveness annually and consideration for funding will be addressed through the budget process.
