ELECTION SIGNAGE AMENDMENT

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF CARDSTON, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO AMEND
BYLAW #1644: ELECTION SIGNAGE BYLAW.

WHEREAS, Section 64 of the Municipal Government Act, Being Chapter M-26, Revised Statutes of Alberta, 2000 provides for the passing of bylaws to amend other bylaws;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Town of Cardston, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

AMENDMENTS

- 1) That Section 3 of Bylaw #1644 be amended to read as follows:
- 3) Election Signs are not to be placed prior to the nomination day of the election.
