ELECTRICITY DISTRIBUTION BYLAW

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF CARDSTON IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO PROVIDE FOR DISTRIBUTION OF ELECTRICITY AND IS TO BE CALLED THE ELECTRICITY DISTRIBUTION BYLAW.

Whereas, pursuant to the *Municipal Government Act*, RSA 2000, M26.1 as amended; and pursuant to the *Electric Utilities Act* RSA 2000, c. E-35, as amended, and any regulations pertaining thereto, and that these Acts and Regulation grant the Municipality certain rights and powers concerning the ownership of electrical distribution systems and their uses.

And Whereas, it is expedient to make provisions for the management and control of the Electrical System of the Town of Cardston, and to provide rules and regulations regarding the use of electricity and the provision of electrical distribution services and to establish a Distribution Tariff, distribution access services of electrical rates and charges, and a Regulated Rate Tariff;

Now therefore, the Council of the Town of Cardston, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

PART I – PURPOSE, DEFINITIONS AND INTERPRETATION

PURPOSE

- 1) The Purpose of this Bylaw is to provide for the distribution of electricity within the Municipality of the Town of Cardston.

PART II – GENERAL

SCHEDULES

- 2) The following schedules are included in and form part of this bylaw:
 - (a) Electricity Distribution – Schedule “A” Distribution Tariff Rate Schedule, dated January 1, 2016;
 - (b) Electricity Distribution – Schedule “B” Distribution Tariff Terms and Conditions;
 - (c) Electricity Distribution – Schedule “C” Cardston Power Distribution Tariff Fee Schedule;

- (d) Electricity Distribution – Schedule “D” The Regulated Rate Option Tariff Terms and Conditions;
- (e) Electricity Distribution – Schedule “E” The Regulated Rate Option Tariff Fee Schedule;
- (f) Electricity Distribution – Schedule “F” The Regulated Rate Option Tariff Energy Price Setting Plan;
- (g) Electricity Distribution – Schedule “G” The Default Supplier Rate Schedule;
- (h) Electricity Distribution – Schedule “H” The Default Supplier Terms and Conditions;
- (i) Electricity Distribution – Schedule “I” The Default Supplier Tariff Price Schedule Fees;
- (j) Electricity Distribution – Schedule “J” The Retail Access Service Agreement.

CONTRACTS

3) The Town of Cardston will engage the services of ENMAX Energy Corporation to provide services as outlined in the following Contracts, which are included in and form part of this bylaw:

- (a) Wire Services, dated January 1, 2011;
- (b) Regulated Rate Option and Default Supplier Services, dated October 29, 2011.

EFFECTIVE DATE

4) This Bylaw shall come in force upon the date of its third and final reading.

REPEAL

5) Bylaw 1606 and amendments there to shall be rescinded.
