By-Law #1622

A By-Law of the Town of Cardston, in the Province of Alberta, for the purpose of correcting a clerical error in By-Law #1620.

Whereas By-Law #1620, a By-Law to Authorize the Rates of Taxation to be Levied Against Assessable Property Within the Municipality for the 2013 Taxation, was given third reading on May 14, 2013; and By-Law #1620, a By-Law to Provide for the Orderly Collection, Removal and Disposal of Garbage and Recycling, was given third reading on September 10, 2013; and

Whereas the Municipal Government Act, Statutes of Alberta, 2000, being Chapter M-26.1 Section 63(1)&(2) authorizes the Council to pass a By-Law to revise By-Laws to correct clerical errors; and

Whereas Council deems that it is necessary to change the numbering for the above noted By-Laws both numbered #1620;

Now therefore, the Council of the Town of Cardston, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, enacts the following:

- That By-Law #1620, a By-Law to Authorize the Rates and Taxation to be Levied Against Assessable Property Within the Municipality for the 2013 Taxation, shall remain in force effective May 14, 2013; and
- 2. That By-Law #1620, a By-Law to Provide for the Orderly Collection, Removal and Disposal of Garbage and Recycling, is to be renumbered as By-Law #1623, and shall be in force as of January 1, 2014.

This Bylaw comes into force on the day it is finally passed.
