BYLAW NO. 1571A

**A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF CARDSTON, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA,
TO AMEND THE COUNCIL PROCEDURAL BYLAW.**

WHEREAS the Municipal Government Act (Statutes of Alberta, 1994, Chapter M-26.1) and amendments thereto, deal with meetings of Council, this ByLaw provides for the regulation of the proceedings of Council and the Committees thereof;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the TOWN OF CARDSTON, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

PART II

GENERAL RULES OF COUNCIL

2. The regular monthly meeting of Council shall commence at 5:00 o'clock P.M. and adjourn at 8:00 o'clock P.M., if in session at that hour, unless otherwise determined by a unanimous vote of the members present. Such a motion passed while in Council may extend the time of adjournment to not later than 10:00 o'clock P.M.

This Bylaw shall take effect and come into force as of the date of the Final reading thereof.


